

**The Data Protection (Fees under section 19(7)) Regulations,  
2002**

**THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 19(7) of the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2001<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it, having regard to the definition of "fees regulations" in section 16(2) of that Law, and after consultation with the Data Protection Commissioner in accordance with section 66(3) of that Law, hereby makes the following Regulations -

**Fees payable under section 19(7).**

1. The fee payable by a member of the public for the supply by the Commissioner under section 19(7) of the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2001 of a duly certified written copy of the particulars contained in any entry made in the register maintained under section 19(1) of that Law is £2.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>b</sup> apply to the interpretation of these Regulations -

(a) throughout the Bailiwick; and

(b) as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment.

(2) Unless the context otherwise requires, references in these Regulations to an enactment are references thereto as amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.


**Citation.**
